Forza 2 is a fast and comfortable custom performance cruising catamaran. Considerable extra-design and a high standard were set at the building stage to assure quality of workmanship, comfort and performance.

She is equipped of twin steering stations with Teleflex-Morse K4 electronic controls, and Raymarine electronics at the main bulkhead aft. She was coated below waterline with copper impregnated epoxy and antifouling paint.

On the comfort side she is equipped with a gas BBQ, a retractable LED TV and a Bose sound system.

An important refit was performed in December 2010, including new paint, new batteries, new toilet and holding tank pumps.

She was newly antifouled, the windows resealed and the rudders, engines, gearboxes, genset and tender outboard engine serviced in February 2013 to set the boat up for trouble free operations for the next years.
